Charopidae	Connolly's afrodonta	<i>Afrodonta connollyi</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	infrequent	endemic to Eastern SA
Charopidae	tonsilled afrodonta	<i>Afrodonta introtuberculata</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	infrequent	endemic to KZN Midlands
Charopidae	nine-toothed afrodonta	<i>Afrodonta novemlamellaris</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	widely distributed in southern Africa
Charopidae	pliculate pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis contabulata</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to KZN and Transkei
Charopidae	perforated pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis permeata</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	infrequent	endemic to KZN
Charopidae	occluded pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis calorama</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	infrequent	endemic to KZN
Charopidae	planorboid pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis contabulata</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to KZN and Transkei
Charopidae	pearly pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis in clara</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, under leaves	common	endemic to Eastern SA
Charopidae	windmill pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis rudicostata</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	widely distributed in southern Africa
Charopidae	milky pinwheel	<i>Trachycystis subpinguis</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, under logs and on tree trunks	common	endemic to Eastern SA
Chlamydephoridae	Burnup's hunter slug	<i>Chlamydephorus burnupi</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, on forest floor	scarce	endemic to Eastern SA, a strange looking orange-brown slug
Cyclophoridae	hairy millipede snail	<i>Chondrocyclus isipingoensis</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	a minute snail, endemic to SA, but widely distributed
Helicarionidae	keeled kalliella	<i>Kaliella barrakporensis</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter and on trees	infrequent	widespread in Africa and Asia
Helicarionidae	rounded kalliella	<i>Kaliella euconuloides</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter and on trees	common	endemic to SA
Hydrocenidae	Benson's hydrocena	<i>Hydrocena noticola</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter and on trees	common	a minute, widely distributed snail
Orculidae	McBean's cask snail	<i>Fauxulus mcbeanianus</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	a forest snail endemic to eastern South Africa
Pomatiasidae	few-ridged shuffler	<i>Tropidophora insularis</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter and on trees	infrequent	widely distributed in southern and East Africa
Punctidae	Hottentot spot	<i>Paraloama hottentota</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	widely distributed in southern and East Africa
Rhytididae	dwarf cannibal snail	<i>Nata vernicosa</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, on forest floor	common	on of the most common and widespread snails in SA; feeds on soft-bodied invertebrates including other snails
Rhytididae	common cannibal snail	<i>Natalina cafra</i>	forest and grassland	common	a spectacular snail, endemic to eastern SA; feeds on soft-bodied invertebrates including other snails, even the large agate snails
Streptaxidae	delicate hunter snail	<i>Gulella delicatula</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	scarce	endemic to KZN
Streptaxidae	pinched-lip hunter snail	<i>Gulella columnella</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to KZN
Streptaxidae	handsome hunter snail	<i>Gulella formosa</i>	forest and grassland, under logs and stones, and in grass clumps	common	endemic to central KZN, generally quite scarce, but surprisingly common at Mbona
Streptaxidae	Isipingo hunter snail	<i>Gulella isipingoensis</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to SA
Streptaxidae	Melville's hunter snail	<i>Gulella melvilli</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to KZN
Subulinidae	scraped awl snail	<i>Opeas strigile</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to the KZN Midlands and East Griqualand
Subulinidae	Burnup's awl snail	<i>Pseudopeas burnupi</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	endemic to the KZN Midlands, East Griqualand and Pondoland
Urocyclidae	Burnup's tail-wagger	<i>Sheldonia burnupi</i>	mist-belt forest-grassland mosaic, on low-growing plants	infrequent	a recently re-discovered species known only from Mbona, Hilton and PMBurg.
Urocyclidae	arboreal tail-wagger	<i>Sheldonia cornea</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, on trees and shrubs	common	endemic to eastern SA
Vertiginidae	Sykes's whorl snail	<i>Truncatellina sykesii</i>	mist-belt Podocarpus forest, in leaf-litter	common	a common forest snail
