WASTE MANAGEMENT

It is preferable that all rubbish be removed off the Reserve as this greatly assists the staff and is far healthier and more environmentally friendly.

1: Shareholders may utilise Mbona's small recycling and garden waste depot, located opposite the trout hatchery, on the right-hand side of the road to the York Gate.

2: Recycling must please be **washed**, separated into glass, tins, plastic, paper and cardboard and placed in the containers in the labelled compartments.

3: **Clean**, unseparated recycling may be left in **clear** plastic bags which are available at the office.

4: Food and biodegradable waste must be composted on your share.

5: Separate containers for light bulbs and batteries are supplied at the recycling depot.

6: Only garden waste may be left on the pile for burning. Plastic bags must be emptied of leaves etc. and added to the plastic recycling.

7: No disposable nappies to be left at the depot please.

8: Large landfill items or old appliances are not to be left at the recycling – shareholders must arrange with management if they are not able to dispose of these items themselves.

9: No building rubble, thatching grass and other discarded building material to be left at this site. As in Contractors agreement, this must be removed from the Reserve.
